





The Commitment

The key founders of each startup must commit their full-time efforts to progressing their startup in the program. Founders are expected to participate in at least 90% of the workshop, accountability sessions and must support promotional activities.

A selection committee reviews applications and invites top innovators to the next stage.



Onboarding

Shortlisted applicants join an interview to assess program fit. Successful participants receive a formal offer by 7th April.



Program Begins

The accelerator kicks off on 23rd April and runs through 28th August with scheduled breaks.

Plant Vitality Accelerator Program Curriculum

The Plant Vitality Accelerator is an intensive fivemonth program running from April to August, with a break during the school holidays.

Sessions are structured to provide both strategic guidance and hands-on mentorship.

Workshops will take place every Wednesday morning (2 hours), running from 23rd April to 25th June, and resume on 16th July after the break.

In addition, weekly one-hour mentoring sessions are held every Friday, offering tailored support from industry experts. The program culminates in a high-profile industry showcase, where participants present their solutions to investors, growers, and key decision-makers.
